

Membership at Haddington Golf Club

Haddington Golf Club is The 19th Oldest Golf Course in the World !

Located a half-mile (1 km) northeast of Haddington, Amisfield Park is today the home of Haddington Golf Club. It was once the estate of the infamous gambler hellraiser Colonel Francis Charteris, whose daughter married James, 5th Earl of Wemyss (1699 - 1756).

This was once the site of Amisfield House, regarded as the finest example of Orthodox Palladianism in Scotland, which was built c.1755 by Isaac Ware for Francis Charteris of Wemyss, who inherited the estate, but not the title, from his father. It was extended in 1785 but was demolished in 1928.

A modern clubhouse for the Haddington Golf Club now occupies the site of the house, but the stable-block by John Henderson (1785) remains, although is in poor condition (2001), along with an ice-house, temple, walled garden and grand gate piers situated at the west entrance from Haddington.

Haddington Golf Club is proud of its reputation as a friendly and welcoming Club, which places great emphasis on new members feeling at home from the moment they join. To this end, there is currently no joining fee – we want to make it as simple as possible for you to simply throw the clubs in the boot and get out on the course, and with its easy reach of transportation links you’ll be able to do this frequently!

Golf Competitions and Sections

There are a variety of competitions held throughout the week and are listed in more detail in your Club fixture list including

- Monday - Senior Ladies competition
- Tuesday - Stableford competition
- Wednesday - Ladies competition and senior stableford
- Saturday - Ladies competition, stableford competition or team competition
- Sunday - Club medals or team competition

Optional matchplay evens run throughout the year.

We also have a variety of Golf Sections that offer further competitions and fun events throughout the year as well as teams playing in Lothian Leagues.

Access to a Quality Course: being a member gives you the opportunity to play when you like, as often as you like and how you like, whether you enjoy the challenge of weekly competition or a relaxing social game. The course is great fun to play for golfers whatever their ability. There are a variety of holes both picturesque and challenging.

Competitive Golf: membership allows you to play regular ladies, men's, senior and junior club competitions throughout the summer season including medal, stableford, bogey, knockout and team events.

Thriving Seniors Section: the club has a thriving men's Seniors Section which also organises ten friendlies each year alternating between home and away. There are also league matches against other clubs across the Lothians which gives a great opportunity to play other courses and meet fellow golfers from different clubs. There is also a Senior Stableford every Wednesday.

Fantastic Ladies Section: Haddington GC has a fantastic Ladies Section which hold organised competitions on Wednesdays and Saturdays and participate in regular competitive team matches against other clubs in the area. Ladies can participate in all the club stablefords and medals.

Friendly Clubhouse Environment: our clubhouse is a great place for eating, drinking and socialising with your friends or family. Children are made welcome, and we are dog friendly.

Extras: Haddington GC members can book the Clubhouse Dining Room and Lounge room for private functions (subject to availability).

Networking and Friendships: membership of Haddington Golf Club is a great way to network with other people from the area and make life-long friendships with other members.

Online Booking System: Tee times for competitions and casual golf can all be booked online quickly and easily via the club mobile phone app or the website.

Get an Official Club Handicap: only by being a member you can attain an official CONGU handicap. Playing competitions regularly at Haddington GC will allow you to get a handicap which reflects your playing standard.

Play in Matches against other Clubs: being part of the club, you have opportunity of representing Haddington GC in matches against other clubs in your local area.

Invite Your Friends: Haddington GC offers preferential 'Members' Guest Rate' green fees giving you the chance to invite your friends to play your course. By making this reciprocal among your golfing friends, you can play many great courses at a fraction of the normal price.

Managing a Handicap

At Haddington Golf Club your handicap is maintained seamlessly.

Haddington Golf Club are fully up to date and using the new World Handicapping System (WHS) which allows a players Handicap Index (HI) to be transported between courses and countries.

Handicaps will be updated each time you play a competition round during the summer season. In addition, you can submit "general play" scores using the Scottish Golf app or HowDidIDo app. At HGC these general play rounds can be over 9 or 18 holes, 7 days a week.

Depending on their category, Members are free to play any day of the week, whether it be social golf or a handicap counting round.
