2. RESPECT, BEHAVIOUR AND DRESS

Wear appropriate golfing attire and footwear.



Avoid clothing likely to cause offence or confrontation.



Use respectful and appropriate language at all times.



Treat staff, members, guests and visitors with courtesy.



Never behave aggressively, abusively or in a threatening manner.

3. GOLF ETIQUETTE AND CARE OF THE COURSE

All players are expected to help maintain the condition of the course and facilities.

BEFORE PLAYING



Book a tee time for every round.



Check in at the Pro Shop before starting play.

PRACTICE FACILITIES



Use only range balls provided.



Do not remove range balls from the practice area.



Do not enter the range to retrieve balls.



Return empty range baskets to the Pro Shop.

ON THE COURSE



Repair pitch marks on greens.



Replace or fill divots where appropriate.



Rake bunkers after use.



Remove broken tees from teeing areas.



Follow all course signage and trolley restrictions.



Dispose of litter responsibly or take it home.



Respect practice facilities and use them correctly.



All play must be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf and any local rules in force.
